What information do we collect?

- We collect email addresses.
- Registration: on some parts of the site we ask you to register, and if you do we ask for your name, email address, and other personal information.

- We may also use cookies. For an explanation, see the section on cookies below.

We will only disclose your information to other third parties for the following purposes:

2. If we are required to do so by law or if we receive a valid request by the police or government department investigating an illegal activity.
3. To other members in our group of companies including and subsidiaries and holding companies.
4. In order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk).

We will not disclose your information to any third party for their marketing purposes.

We may use your personal information to:

1. Administer the website.
2. Improve your browsing experience by personalising the website.
3. Enable your use of the services available on the website.
4. Send to you goods purchased via the website, and supply to you services purchased via the website.
5. Send statements and invoices to you, and collect payments from you.

6. Send you general (non-marketing) commercial communications.

8. 9. Provide third parties with statistical information about our users – but this information will not be used to identify any individual user.

Use of Cookies
